

Health and Safety Guidelines for the use of the Tech2O Center

As of January 2021, the Carlos M. Ramirez Tech₂O Learning Center remains closed to the public. EPWater may continue to utilize the Center's conference spaces for training and/or testing, including TEEX training.

The Center is not open for use by outside organizations at this time. Exceptions will be considered for fire and police training needs. To protect visitors and employees, the following new health and safety guidelines have been established to help encourage social distancing and minimize potential spread of the virus.

What we are doing (and not doing)

- We have provided new directional signs for entering and exiting the Center to assist in social distancing.
- Multiple hand sanitizing dispensers are available at entrances to the facility and conference spaces.
- Daily cleaning is standard, and disinfection is arranged for the weeks when events are scheduled.
- All training and testing events must conclude by 5:00 to allow for cleaning and disinfection.
- In certain areas, we will provide tape, signs, orange cones on the floor, or signage to encourage social distancing.
- Doors to the restrooms and reception areas will remain open to avoid touching by multiple people.
- Signs are installed outside of restrooms to encourage people to wait and observe social distancing.
- We have closed the kitchen and will not allow catering at this time.
- We are limiting access to certain areas of the Center, including the exhibit halls.

What we are requiring of you

- All employees and visitors must use a mask or face cloth covering while at the Tech₂O Center and use hand sanitizer upon entering building.
- Facility capacity limitations have been set at 50%.
- Visitors are expected to observe 6-foot social distancing guidelines when in common areas.
- Please respect all signage and access limitations that have been set to protect all of us.
